Yellow shaded areas indicate the preferred time of year for an average adult horse to receive the above vaccinations. Spring vaccines are split into two visits to maximize the immune system's response to the vaccines administered. The Coggins test and Dental Power Float can be performed at any time of year. However, we prefer to perform your horse's Dental Exam and/or Power Float during his less active winter months to ensure that your horse is eating and grinding his food properly. In addition, we aim to detect bit and oral problems well in advance of his competitive show season. Strangles vaccination is preferred during January and February to protect your horse before he starts travelling for show season. Foals, broodmares, breeding stallions and horses with greater risk factors such as increased travel for showing will require additional vaccinations. Please call our office (781) 585-2611 or ask one of our veterinarians for vaccine recommendations for these animals.
